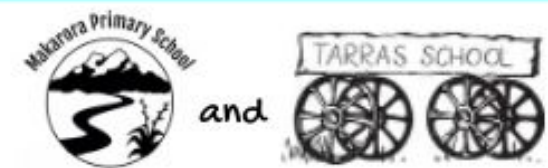

We have recently secured some funding through Toimata Foundation, One Billion Trees Programme and Te Uru Rākau NZ Forest Service (TURNZFS) to support the ecological restoration work that schools do on their grounds and in their communities. It is hoped that the \$375 from this will support the purchase of a tunnel house to grow native plants to potentially plant on school grounds or sell to local landowners.

Pine cones for sale on the produce stand - \$5 a bag. All current donations will be going towards upgrading the irrigation system on the school gardens so students can grow bigger and better vegetables and flowers in the future.

Thank you to all community members who donated their swimming pool key deposit to school to support the continued costs of running the pool.
