It records temperature, wind, humidity, rainfall and barometer readings. The station is situated at 400m above sea level so day-time temperatures are slightly cooler and night time slightly warmer than at lower elevations in the district.

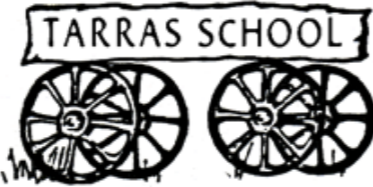
